Treasurer Report

Natalie reported that the booster club is now a registered nonprofit with the State of Texas – making it a separate entity outside McCallum. The booster officers will finalize bylaws soon and set up a bank account for new deposits only. Currently, the booster club has \$9,685.12 at McCallum, pending a few expenses (\$650) and possibly some funds from last year's Cabaret through Ludus.

The booster club officers will also look into ways to transition the nonprofit to a 501c3.

Booster and Choir Program Websites, Including Charms

Ashli encouraged attendees to sign up for Charms emails if they haven't already.

Updates and Look-Backs

- Back to School Knight: The choir booster table was a success and low effort.
- Uniform Fittings: It was a huge undertaking this year with limited volunteers. Next year's effort needs more organization and time.
- Volunteers October 4 Concert (4): Two volunteers handed out programs, and two sat with students. Next year it would be helpful for a parent to put together the program and pass a basket for donations.
- Volunteers TMEA Region Auditions (5): Two parents worked on goodie bags for students auditioning. Next year, two volunteers (instead of one) per time slow would work better even though there is a lot of downtime.
- Letter Jackets: Letter jackets ordered this past spring have arrived. All but one or two have been distributed. The booster club contributes \$60 per jacket. Mr. Carter updated the letter jacket program for this year.
- **Region Fees:** Mr. Carter is working on collecting fees (\$25) for students that signed up. Nine of 33 have paid. He will get an email reminder out soon. Seven students made the region mixed choir and advanced to the pre-area round of competition that will take place on November 18.
- **Tux Shirts:** Mr. Carter is working on collecting tux shirt fees.

- Fair Share Donations: Mr. Carter reported that 42 of 89 students paid their fair share donations (\$85). He will get an email out to parents soon to remind them about the payment and payment options.
- Choir Events and Booster Support for Cabaret: Mr. Nelson will assist Mr. Carter with Cabaret this year. Cabaret dates will move from mid-November to December 1-4. Parent Tanya DaMommio will chair the whole effort.

Upcoming Booster Initiative: 2022-23 Choir T-Shirts

Choir shirt designs will be solicited and voted on by students. Booster Club parents/guardians will review designs.
