### **Senior blanket update**

### **Solo & Ensemble**

- No parents will be allowed in FABT; may be in Cafeteria or outside waiting
- Food drop-off: we have old ice coolers that could house food if dropped off early
- Will have 6 judges, exec. secretary, Cheryl, Malcolm
- Suggestion that students sing solo & leave; we are not posting results during the day. Directors can notify students.
- Each school will audition mostly in 1 room only except us, as we have 50 entries. Probably will be in 2 rooms.
- How long is a time slot, in general? Thirty minutes early in morning. If singing in afternoon, maybe a little earlier than 30 minutes in case we are running ahead.
- Dana will be there all day, will orient volunteers
- Will also have signage at doors

### **Banquet update**

- Capacity issues at PAC. Kelley is asking Jacob (events coordinator) about foyer, max capacity is about 150 people

- Sound equipment? Will ask PAC
